For the past 4 years, William Penn House has led a Workcamp on Pine Ridge, South Dakota. While learning about life on "The Rez" and the history of The Badlands, we also get to know the people of the land, their current struggles, hopes, and dreams. We support the continuation of sacred traditions while developing a vision of the future. Sundance Ceremonies, Pow Wows, sharing stories and sharing meals are all part of the experience.

This is a multi-generational, intercultural program developed in partnership with Mike Gray who has been leading Workcamps on Pine Ridge for almost two decades. Participants will have the option of participating for 1 or 2 weeks.

Dates: July 23 to August 7

Estimated Costs: \$850 for one week; \$1550 for both weeks. Includes meals, lodging, and transportation in South Dakota. Does not include transportation to/from Rapid City, SD
